Monday August 8: We will begin this picture-perfect vacation by traveling as far as Quebec City where we will spend our first night away from home. We will make several coffee stops, as well as lunch as we travel along today. I have arranged a Group Dinner for you this Evening (included).

Tuesday August 9: This morning after breakfast at the Hotel (included) we will depart from Quebec City and travel North East through the Jacques-Cartier National Park which is located in the Laurentian Mountains. The park is also located near the Canadian Forces Military base CFB Valcartier. The Park contains several glacial landforms. The most prominent glacial landform is the

Jacques-Cartier U-shaped Valley which is 550 meters deep and was formed during the last glacial period.

We will arrive mid-morning in the City of Saguenay which is known for the famous Saguenay Fjord which leads to the St. Lawrence River. We will stop here for a short visit and take time to purchase our picnic lunches to be eaten at the docks of L'anse Saint-Jean or on the Boat Cruise.

This afternoon we will cruise the Fjord onboard a sightseeing boat. The southernmost Fjord in the world, the Saguenay Fjord was carved out near the very edge of the North American continental ice sheet. For almost its entire length, the sides of the Fjord are steep cliffs over 900 feet high. This being a narrated cruise, you will learn about the history and legends of the Saguenay Fjord, as you explore its majestic capes and impressive cliffs. You will have the perfect opportunity to get close to capture superb photos of this spectacular geological phenomenon...Don't forget your Camera!! Once we arrive back on land, we will make our way to LaMalbaie, where we will overnight at the beautiful Le Petit Manoir with views of the St. Lawrence River. To top off our adventurous day, we will enjoy a 3- Course Dinner at the Hotel (included). Enjoy the rest of the evening.

Wednesday August 10: After a restful night we will enjoy a full American Breakfast at the Hotel before we depart for Old Quebec City.

As we travel along the scenic St. Lawrence River, we will make our 1st stop at the quaint & beautiful village of Baie-Saint-Paul known for its art galleries, shops & restaurants. It also ranks among Canada's Cultural Capitals. We will continue our morning passing by Mont-Sainte-Anne a popular Ski Resort which has a summit elevation of 800 m above sea level with a vertical drop of 635 m., before we stop in Sainte Anne- du Beupre for Lunch (on your own).

After Lunch you will be able to spend some time visiting the Basilica of Sainte-Anne-de-Beaupre and the wooded hillside which has a Memorial Chapel and the Way of the Cross depicted with life-sized Stations of the Cross.

We will then take the old Kings Highway with its very narrow country roads to a unique little place called Chez Marie where you are in for a real treat.

Mid Afternoon we will continue towards Quebec City, but first we will visit the Island of Orleans which celebrates Quebec's rural tradition with its gorgeous scenery stretching along the banks of the St. Lawrence River.

You will experience the rich and vibrant culture of this Island jewel which is the birthplace of New France. The Island is noted for its rich soil which grows ample vegetables and fruit. We will pass by beautiful Vineyards and Strawberry fields, with a special stop for fresh Strawberries, as they are grown here until late September.

As our Afternoon comes to an end, we will leave the Island of Orleans. As we pass over the bridge to the main land you will have a magnificent view of the Montmorency Falls so have your camera ready.

We will drive a short distance where we will unpack and stay 2-nights at the beautiful Hotel Quebec. We will enjoy a delicious Group Dinner at the Hotel this evening (included).

Thursday August 11: After a restful night we will enjoy a full breakfast at the hotel (included). As we start our last day in Quebec, we will welcome onboard a local Tour Guide who will enlighten us this morning with a Historical Tour of Old Quebec. The highlights include-The Plains of Abraham, Cape Diamond, The Joan of Arc Garden, Grande-Allee, Parliament, Place d'Armes, Old Quebec, Chateau Frontenac, Place Royal and much more!

The afternoon will be free time for you do have lunch, enjoy some shopping and sight-seeing as you go back in time exploring beautiful Old Quebec City. This evening after another eventful day we will enjoy a farewell Dinner at Hotel Quebec (included).

Friday August 12: After Breakfast this morning, with much regrets we will say good-bye to our new adventure's here in Quebec, but will take with us many new memories and friendships which will last a life time.

As we travel towards home today, we will take several breaks along the way arriving home early evening.
